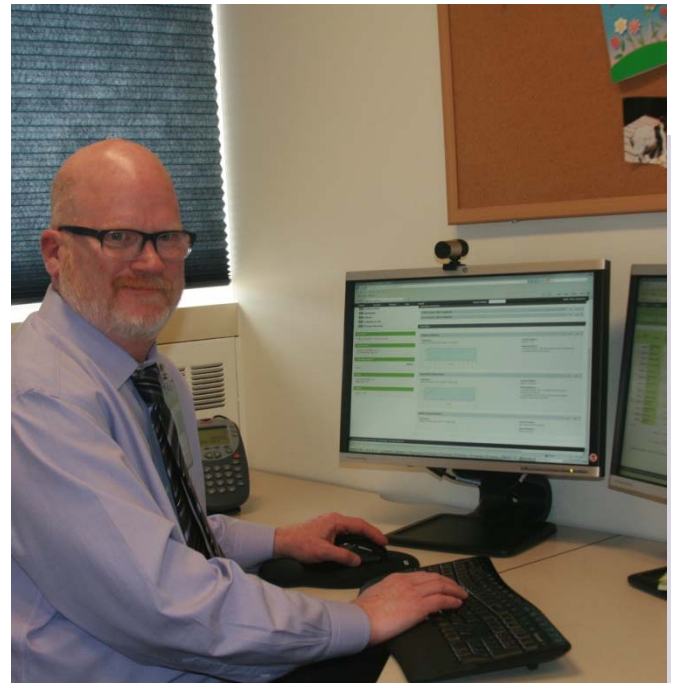
# Applying the Integrated Care Approach: *Practical Skills for the Psychiatric Consultant*

Psychiatrists can dramatically improve the reach and impact of mental health services using integrated care approaches. This free, four hour training is an excellent introduction to providing effective mental health care for populations whether you are part of an integrated care team or run a private practice.

Topics include:

- Initiating treatment in team care
- Common presentations in primary care
- Team functioning
- Lessons for individual practices
