*Legal requirements in Washington State require mental health professionals to complete six (6) hours of training in suicide assessment, treatment, and management. This training has been approved for thirteen (13) CEUs for Washington State Licensed Mental Health Counselors, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists, and Licensed Social Workers. WMHCA Provider #1305. This course also meets/exceeds the requirements for Chemical Dependency Professionals, who are required to complete three (3) hours of training in suicide assessment, screening, and referral.
