WRAP® Level 2 (5 days)

Spend five days learning to become a WRAP Facilitator. This course is designed to help you become a powerful change agent as a WRAP Facilitator. You will gain a deeper understanding of the recovery process and learn to:

- work with people who have mental health challenges to discover the strengths they have and can use to enhance their recovery.
- effectively share the underlying concepts necessary to recovery - hope, personal responsibility, education, self-advocacy, and support.
- work with individuals and groups to develop a WRAP.
- teach about wellness tools and strategies.
- empower and motivate people to work toward recovery – feeling the way they want to feel, making their lives the way they want them to be, and moving toward meeting their life goals.
- use interaction and presentation styles and strategies that enhance recovery.

WRAP Seminar 1: Intro to WRAP is a pre-requisite for WRAP Seminar 2: WRAP for Facilitators - Attendees MUST supply questionnaire answers and appropriate documentation to attend WRAP Seminar 2. An employer note is also required for attendance.
