- Required online training to be completed prior to the 40-hour in person training.
- 40-hour training.
- You cannot miss more than 3 hours of the training or you will not be certified.
- The certification test will take place on the last day of the training.
- People who pass the test can be eligible to work at licensed mental health agencies in Washington State.
- Applicants must be over 18 years old.
